Auction Rules and Information

Silent Auction

All items in the Silent Auction have bid sheets affixed nearby. The bidder must print his or her bid number and amount on bid sheet (bid numbers are to be obtained at the registration desk). A bid constitutes a binding agreement to buy the specified item. All bids must start with the minimum amount indicated on the bid sheet and each bid increase must follow the minimum increment stated. Bidding must stop when the section is declared closed. At the close of each Silent Auction section, an auction official will circle the highest bid. In addition, each Silent Auction item will have a "Buy It Now" price listed on the bid sheet. If a bidder exercises this option, the section will close immediately. In the event of a dispute, the Auction Committee shall have sole and final discretion in determining the winning bidder.

Live Auction

Live Auction items may be viewed from 7:30 pm to 8:30 pm, at which time the Live Auction will begin. All bidders must have a bid number. Bidders raise their bid numbers to make bids. In the Live Auction, the purchaser is the highest bidder acknowledged by the Auctioneer. Certain items may have a reserve price. In the event of a dispute, the Auctioneer will have sole and final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the item in dispute. The decision of the Auctioneer will be final. The winning bidder should continue to hold his or her number aloft until the winning bid has been recorded.

Check-Out

All successful bidders must check out. Bidders shall pay for all purchases in full by cash, check, MasterCard, Visa or American Express at the conclusion of the Live and Silent Auctions. Purchased items that are available at the event must be taken at the end of the event. RHS will coordinate with successful bidders to schedule delivery of large art items, ordered photograph prints, framed posters and DVDs.

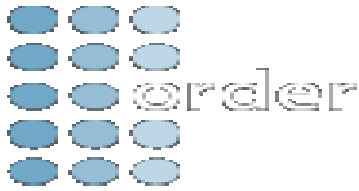

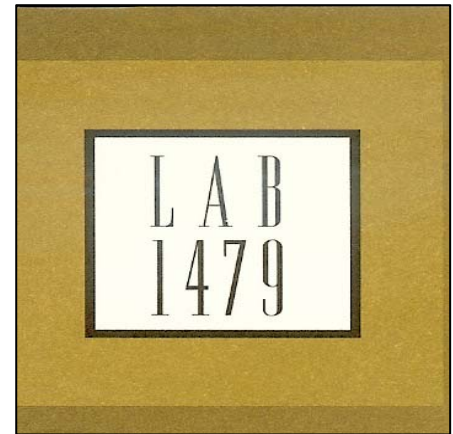
